MASSACHUSETTS HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY The Spring Flower Show Research Aid 1871-2019

Between 1871 and 2008, the Society produced 137 Spring Flower Shows that were the largest and most important horticultural events in the country. This Research Aid lists information about those exhibitions.

The Society was established in 1829 for "the purpose of encouraging and improving the science and practice of Horticulture." To support this mission, the Society's By-Laws provided for exhibitions with awards. In June 1829, the month of its incorporation, the Society began holding weekly exhibitions on Saturdays and a large Annual Exhibition in September. The exhibitions featured fruits, vegetables, ornamental plants, arrangements and cut flowers. Awards bestowed at these exhibitions were highly regarded.

By 1871, the weekly exhibitions became more elaborate and complicated to produce. Therefore, several spring exhibitions were combined into a semi-annual exhibition. At first, those exhibitions were held in June, but by 1879 the shows moved to March. As in the Annual Exhibitions, the exhibitions featured fruits, vegetables, ornamental plants, arrangements and cut flowers. As agricultural production moved west and became industrialized in the late 19th century, the main focus of the shows changed to ornamental horticulture and gardens and the annual spring flower show became the Society's major show of the year.

Over time, the length, size and complexity of the Society's shows grew. The shows were "the event" for horticultural organizations, businesses and professionals and provided a venue to network, compete, learn and promote their goods and services. The public eagerly awaited these annual shows that foreshadowed the brilliant spring days ahead and provided a temporary escape from the fickle weather in March. However, by the beginning of the twenty-first century, society and the economy were changing. The Great Recession in 2007 to 2009, increasing costs, reduced revenues and declining attendance caused many flower shows to cease operations, including the Society's. After its reorganization in 2008, the Society participated in the Boston Flower Show produced by the Paragon Group, as an exhibitor and manager of the show's amateur exhibitions, a role that aligned with its mission, and for which the Society was eminently qualified.

Instead, it was an exhibitor and the manager of the amateur competitions at the "Boston Flower and Garden Shows" produced by The Paragon Group between 2010 and 2019.

The theme of the 2020 Boston Flower and Garden Show was "Garden Party: Celebrating Friends & Family." While the Society and its volunteers completed the installation of its 2020 flower show exhibits, due to the emerging COVID-19 pandemic, it made the decision not to have its staff or volunteers attend the show.

The show, which was scheduled to run from March 11th to 15th, was closed on March 13th due to restrictions imposed under the the Governor's Declaration of a State of Emergency. Paragon Group ceased production of the "Boston Flower and Garden Show" after that date.
